



# Birdie Builders

This activity has been adapted to complete at home and should take about 20mins and is for the Have Adventures theme award.

It's Spring which means birds will be building nests. Have you seen any birds outside collecting twigs?

Birds make nests to keep their eggs safe and when they hatch to keep their babies safe and warm.

Imagine you are a baby bird, what would you want your nest to be like? What would it be made from to keep you warm and safe?



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You are now going to pretend to be a bird collecting things to make a nest. Instead of a beak you are going to use a peg. If you can't pick an object up with the peg a bird wouldn't be able to pick it up either.




You have 10 minutes to collect things for your nest.
